This Week 9-30-19: Bristol Downtown Work

Several Town Council Members joined Town Manager Mitch Mitchell, Majority Builders, Inc. Project Superintendent Steve Nystrand and a representative from JPR Engineering at a weekly progress meeting on the Municipal Building project which adds an extension to the existing town hall to hold both the Town Hall and the Police Dept. The old structure was built in 1914, and the west half was the fire department with trucks exiting at back of building where some additional support had to be added. Later the building was the police department and even had a jail. As work continued on the inside of the old Police Dept. which will become the new ground-level Town Council meeting room, It was discovered that hidden beneath drywall were some issues that needed to be done inside and out to insure continuity. Now somewhat behind schedule due also move electric poles, which caused crews to be relocated to other projects, crews are now being returned to hasten the work. The date for completion is March of 2020, if weather conditions allow the outside work. The new extended parking lot will require Apollo Street to be closed permanently between SR 120 and Elkhart St. The only entrance from Apollo from SR 120 will be into the parking lot.
