The Elkhart Co. Genealogical Society (ECGS) held their first of a number of planned Elkhart County Cemetery tours on Sat., Aug. 19, 2017. The tour included a number of small cemeteries: Adams-Neff in Jefferson Twp.; Geisinger Cemetery (aka Cooper Burying Ground in Middlebury Twp.; Cornell Cemetery in Jefferson Twp.; St. John's Catholic Cemetery, aka Morris Cemetery in Jefferson Twp., Pleasant View Cemetery in Jefferson Twp.; Pine Creek Cemetery in Jefferson Twp., and Little Creek Cemetery and Cremation Garden in Jefferson Twp. Thirteen met at Hardings in Bristol and two more joined at Adams-Neff and Mr. DeWilde, the Cornell Cemetery sexton joined them there and talked about the cemetery history. Cynthia Miller gave a presentation at Adams-Neff, and Carlene Stanley Willings told about the history of Morris-St. John's Catholic Cemetery. Amanda Joynt told about her family buried at Pleasant View and Pine Creek Cemetery.
